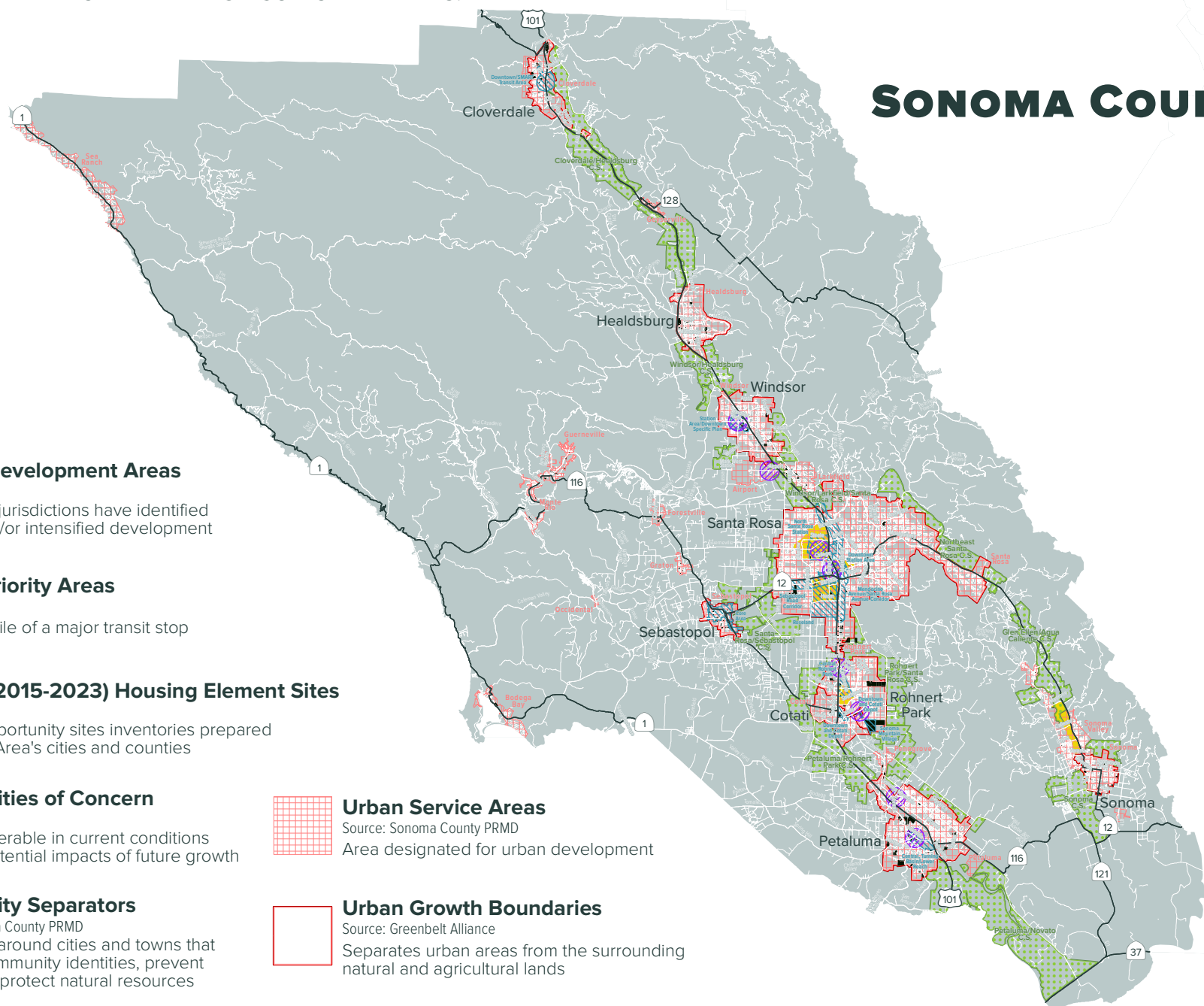
Urban Service Areas
